## GASLAMP QUARTER

This 16-block district is packed with bars, restaurants, theaters, nightclubs and historic architecture. See the renovated **Horton Plaza Park**, a public gathering space with an amphitheater, murals and a domed fountain built in 1910. Check out Fifth Avenue—the center of the district—and find craft beer at **Barleymash** and **Quad AleHouse**, a convivial brunch scene at **Rustic Root**, Spanish tapas at **Cafe Sevilla** and a posh steakhouse-meets-nightclub at **STK**. Dance the night away at **Omnia**, **Fluxx**, **Parq**, **Bang Bang** or **AD Nightclub**. History buffs will want to book a reservation at the **Grant Grill** inside the art deco US Grant hotel, and see the building on Fifth Avenue and E Street that once housed a gambling hall owned by Wyatt Earp.

## EAST VILLAGE

Right next to Petco Park, this neighborhood has come alive with upscale hotels and plenty of dining options. Have a drink with a view at **Altitude Sky Lounge**, an open-air rooftop bar overlooking the ballpark, or at **The Nolen** for incredible cityscape vistas. Head to **Cat Eye Club** for tiki cocktails, gourmet bites and karaoke. Dine in an Italian food hall at **Bottega Americano**, or sample California cuisine at **Jsix**. New in town is the luxury 12-story **Pendry Hotel**, which has a sprawling pool deck and six drinking and dining venues, including the **Fifth & Rose** lounge and **Oxford Social Club**. **The Quartyard**—the city's first shipping container park, with a beer garden, café and event stage—has a new location on the corner of 13th and Market streets.
